Dinners

I have attached the order sheet for you to fill in and also a more detailed menu sheet for your information. As always we need to have the menus and if relevant, payment through either cash or School Money (which will be put on the system once the order has been returned to school). Please remember as your child/ren go up to the next year group that all children in Years Reception through to Year 2 are entitled to free meals but the dinner order still needs to be returned to school by 23rd July to be able to order them.

This is a simple procedure – you only need to put in a national insurance no. The benefits to you and your children are much more than just the free meals.
