



Maths:

We will be building on our knowledge multiplication and division, with multiples of 2, 5 & 10.

We will be looking at simple fractions as well as place value.

In geometry we will be investigating position and direction.

In measurement we will be covering length, height, weight and volume.

Science:

Plants: We will be making seasonal observations as Spring moves into Summer. We will be identifying & naming a variety of common wild & garden plants, including deciduous & evergreen trees.

We will be identifying & describing the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

Materials: we will be learning about everyday materials and their properties. We will be designing an investigation using different materials.

Art & Design:

We will be observing our outdoor environment and drawing it using different media.

We will be looking at the works of Andy Goldsworthy and creating art/ sculpture using natural materials.

Cooking & Nutrition:

We will be continuing to learn the Common Exception Words and use them in our writing.

Geography:

We will be using aerial photographs to recognise landmarks and to devise a simple map, using basic map symbols in a key.

We will be using simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of the school grounds and Forest School area and the features of the surrounding environment.

Music:

We will be listening to & responding to different styles of music. We will begin to recognise styles of music, find the pulse, recognise instruments, listen & discuss other dimensions of music.

We will be learning to play untuned & tuned percussion.

PE:

Our focus will be on Athletics. We will be participating in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.

Computing:

We will be using tablets and computers to do research on our science and geography topics.

We will be learning how to keep ourselves safe online.
