Personal, Social & Emotional Development:

We will be working on playing together, taking turns and listening to other's ideas.

We will be developing our confidence to try new activities and to speak in a group about our ideas.

We will be learning about our feelings & behaviour, how to work as group and how to adapt our behaviour to different situations. Zippy's Friends will help us do this.

Physical Development:

We will be accessing the outdoors to help development our gross motor movements, using the bikes, scooters and climbing mountain.

Reception will be focusing on Athletics in PE, learning to work together as a team. We will be keeping ourselves healthy through our regular exercise & healthy snacks & cooking.

EYFS (Preschool & Reception)

'Play is the most natural way for children to learn.'

We will be following the children's interests as well as working with them in small groups. We will be observing and assessing through our interactions with the children.

Communication & Language:

We will be listening to stories, thinking about what happens next and respond to what we hear with comments, questions or actions.

We will be beginning to answer 'how' and 'why' questions about what we have been doing or about stories we have heard.

We will be developing our own narratives and stories, connecting ideas.

Our focused texts (Poppy and The Blooms and The Three Bears) will help us with this.

Literacy:

We will continue to have daily phonics sessions, with preschool focusing on listening skills and phonological awareness and Reception continuing to learn new 'sounds' and apply them to their reading & writing.

We will continue to become more confident with our mark making and writing, being able to tell you what we've written.. We will be aiming to write phonetically correct sentences

Maths:

We will continue to recognise numbers in our environment, learning to count objects and compare them, investigating less and more. Reception will develop their skills to begin to complete simple addition and] subtraction, in the everyday things that we do. We will be solving problems involving doubling, halving, addition and subtraction.

Understanding The World:

We will share family customs and celebrations, learning about similarities and differences among communities and traditions.

Our RE focus on

Understanding Christianity will help this.

We will be observing our natural

environment and the changes that occur. Our weekly Forest School sessions will help with this.

We will use relevant technology in the classroom. This may include cameras to take photos of what we have done & interactive games to support our learning.

Expressive Arts & Design:

We will continue to explore a variety of materials through our modelling area and our clay/dough area. We will be able to experiment with colour & design. We will be able to present our own ideas through our designs, art, music, dance, role play & stories.
