Internet Safety

As part of our on- going safeguarding and e safety updates it has been flagged up to us by the police and the Safeguarding team that there are a number of Apps that children across the country are using that are inappropriate and unsafe. Without going into too much graphic detail the Apps are places that can be infiltrated by criminals. The apps that the police are concerned about are: Musically, Lively, Omegle, Oovoo and Saraha. These apps allow the children to talk to strangers, communicate using video and all are completely open to anyone on the internet. Whilst we are not in the job of scaring everyone, the advice being given to us is to ensure that all parents are aware of the dangers of the internet.

If you are unsure of how to sort out parental controls on tablets, laptops, Xboxes etc you can ring 08088005002 and they will help you set up any controls that you need. In addition to putting parental control on these things they can also set time limits etc.
