Report Cards Y1-Y6

Parent Consultations

All parents (including pre-school parents) have an opportunity to discuss their child's progress with the class teacher on either Mon 15th November or Tuesday 16th November for Classes 1 and 3 or on Tuesday 16th November for Class 2.
