As you know, this week we have been doing our absolute best to ensure school remains open as staff absences have increased. Covid Update

This week has shown to us the importance of regular Lateral Flow testing from all. Although not legally required, staff are testing daily to ensure children and adults within the school community stay safe. Attached to this newsletter is the Local Authority guidance on testing (we will update you with any changes). Any of these three symptoms; **new continuous cough, high temperature, loss of taste or smell** still requires a PCR test, which needs to be booked in at a test centre, with results sent back to school before return.

We appreciate that Lateral flows are difficult to get hold of but regularly testing as a family really helps.

Reporting Absence

Please report all absences to Mrs Thompson in the office via phone call before 9.30am. Teachers do not always check their emails for absence, and contacting the office directly ensures the correct information is put down for your child.
