Bromesberrow and Bromsberrow Heath Speeding Campaign

The school has teamed up with Bromsberrow Parish Council to work together to tackle the traffic speed in Bromsberrow Heath and speed of traffic outside of the school. This has been of concern to us for a while and we are so pleased to have the support of the local parish and district councillors. A first step is to get some '20 is plenty' signage up in Albright Lane and around Bromsberrow Heath. The Parish Council have asked for the children of Bromesberrow school to design their own '20 is plenty signs' which will be put forward in a competition to select the best signage to support the campaign. We would love to see the children's designs up and about and making a difference! Attached is a competition sheet. The Parish and District Councils are also working with us to look to establish some flashing light indicators to say outside school is a 20 mile an hour zone. We will update you as things develop and we know more.



Parking on the Triangle
